

## Guidelines 6/2022: Ranking of students

Effective from October 1, 2022.

---

These Guidelines specify the methodology for determining the ranking of students according to their academic performance in the previous academic year for study programs in a foreign language at Institute of Economic Studies, namely:

- Bachelor in Economics and Finance (BEF),
- Master in Economics and Finance (MEF), and
- Master in Finance and Data Analytics (MFDA)

following the Dean's Measure 15/2022 Procedure for submitting requests for reducing or waiving the fee for studies in a foreign language.

### Methodology for BEF

- Qualifying condition: at least 45 credits in the previous academic year.
- Ranking based on Adjusted Grade Point Average (AGPA) in the previous academic year:

$$AGPA_{BEF} = CREDIT\_WEIGHTED\_MEANSIS - ((CREDSIS - 60) * 0.01)$$

Where:

- *CREDIT\_WEIGHTED\_MEANSIS*: the credit-weighted study (grade point) average from all courses in previous year registered in SIS, considering all attempts (A=1, B=1.5, C=2, D=2.5, E=3, F=4)
- *CREDSIS*: number of credits achieved in the previous academic year

*Note: Transferred credits collected during studies elsewhere prior the previous academic year will not be considered for verification of the qualifying condition and will not be included in the AGPA.*

### Methodology for MEF

- Qualifying condition: at least 45 credits in the previous academic year
- Ranking based on Adjusted Grade Point Average (AGPA) in the previous academic year:

$$AGPA_{MEF} = CREDIT\_WEIGHTED\_MEANSIS - ((CREDSIS - 60) * 0.01) - (COMPULS\_COMPLETED * 0.1)$$

Where:

- *CREDIT\_WEIGHTED\_MEANSIS*: the credit-weighted study (grade point) average from all courses in previous year registered in SIS, considering all attempts (A=1, B=1.5, C=2, D=2.5, E=3, F=4)
- *CREDSIS*: number of credits achieved in the previous academic year
- *COMPULS\_COMPLETED*: number of compulsory courses (1,2 or 3) completed in the previous academic year

*Note: Transferred credits collected during studies elsewhere prior the previous academic year will not be considered for verification of the qualifying condition and will not be included in the AGPA.*

### **Methodology for MFDA**

- Qualifying condition: at least 45 credits in the previous academic year
- Ranking based on Adjusted Grade Point Average (AGPA) in the previous academic year:

$$AGPA_{MFDA} = CREDIT\_WEIGHTED\_MEANSIS - ((CREDSIS - 60) * 0.01) - (COMPULS\_COMPLETED * 0.1)$$

Where:

- *CREDIT\_WEIGHTED\_MEANSIS*: the credit-weighted study (grade point) average from all courses in the previous academic year registered in SIS, considering all attempts (A=1, B=1.5, C=2, D=2.5, E=3, F=4)
- *CREDSIS*: number of credits achieved in the previous academic year
- *COMPULS\_COMPLETED*: number of compulsory courses (1 to 7) completed in the previous academic year

*Note: Transferred credits collected during studies elsewhere prior the previous academic year will not be considered for verification of the qualifying condition and will not be included in the AGPA.*
